Time: K- 2nd graders: 9am-12pm, 3rd graders-6th graders 1:30-4:30

Cost: \$60, members get 10% off, full and partial Kiwanis scholarships available

Important Considerations: We will be entirely outside and very active during this day camp program, so please be sure all participants are wearing comfortable walking shoes and appropriate outdoor play clothes that you will be comfortable with them getting messy while wearing! Please provide your child with a water bottle, sunscreen, sun hat, and bug spray if needed. While the Turner center provides shade we will be outside for this 3 hour period. We also ask that the Contact and Release form is filled out and returned to the LAC at least 48hrs before the program starts.

On the 28th and 30th participants **should be dropped off and picked up at Brewery Flats Roundhouse Road Fishing access parking lot** (see attached image). Please arrive by 9am or 1:30 pm depending on your child's age group. We will walk over to the Turner Education
Center as a group 5 minutes after start time. Parents should be back at the parking lot ready for pick up by 12:00 or 4:30 depending on your child's age group

On the 29th Day camp participants should be dropped off and picked up at Frank Day Park Tire playground structure.

There will be no available childcare between the hour of 12:00 and 1:30. This is the time our staff will use to prepare for the next group and take their lunch break. Please plan to arrive no earlier than 10 minutes before class starts and pick up no later than 10 minutes after class ends. Please call and/or arrange alternative transportation in the event of a late pick-up.

What to Bring: (Preferably in a backpack or day bag. The LAC is not responsible for lost personal items)

- Sunscreen
- Water Bottle
- Weather appropriate mess clothes**
- outdoor / walking shoes
- Hair ties for those with long hair
- Extra tie-dye garments

**Mess Clothes: Please dress your child appropriately for outdoor, creative, messy fun! Aprons and paint shirts will not be provided so please be aware that paint, dye or other substances may get on clothing. Be prepared for changing weather with outside play. Participants may want to bring a jacket, a raincoat,or sun protection if needed.

Each child will be provided with one t-shirt to participate in a day of **Tie-Dying on the 28th**. If your child would like to tie-dye more personal articles, they are welcome to bring any **light** colored cotton garment (no underwear please) **Please bring all additional articles in a** ziplock bag with your child's name clearly marked on it on the morning of the 28th

Families will be notified as soon as possible by the LAC staff if there is a heavy chance of inclement or severe weather forecasted during camp days. **So please be sure to provide accurate and up- to- date contact information**. Camp days resulting in a rainout will be preemptively relocated to the LAC classroom as far in advance as possible.
